<p>Each June, Pride Month is celebrated with the goal of uplifting and celebrating LGBTQ+ voices and culture, through a series of events, rallies, art exhibits, and festivals. It is celebrated in June to commemorate the anniversary of the Stonewall Uprising, a pivotal event in LGBTQ+ history. Although forms of LGBTQ+ pride events have been present many decades; Pride month was not federally recognized until 1999 when President Bill Clinton declared June as "Gay and Lesbian Pride Month."
