## Functions of Oakland Community Health Network

Oakland Community Health Network (OCHN) leads a provider service network that assists approximately 29,000 Oakland County citizens at more than 400 service sites across the county.

As the Pre-Paid Inpatient Health Plan (PIHP) and Community Mental Health Service Provider (CMHSP) in Oakland County, OCHN's key functions are to:

- Ensure the community has access to quality behavioral health services
- Manage a \$500 million budget funded by the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services, general fund, grants, and Oakland County
- Monitor the provider network to ensure federal and state guidelines are followed
- Manage the Office of Recipient Rights to advocate for people who receive public behavioral health services
