What is an Independent Facilitator?

An independent facilitator is an individual who aids the Person-Centered Planning (PCP) process alongside the person receiving supports.

Individuals receiving services through Oakland Community Health Network (OCHN) are able to choose an independent facilitator.

Why use an Independent Facilitator?

Independent Facilitators:

- Develop a person-centered plan alongside the individual outlining their goals
- Provide support for individual in achieving their goals
- Keep focus on the individual
- Ensure individual is heard/understood
- Provide information/guidance
- Facilitate person-centered planning meetings, or support individual in facilitating their own meetings
- Assist individual with all pre-meeting requirements, including inviting participants chosen by the individual
- Assist individual in choosing planning tools during their person-centered planning process
