## Justice Service Navigation

The SSU is a sobering and monitoring program for people experiencing side effects of drug and alcohol misuse.

**Sober Support Unit (SSU)**

Individuals are connected to employment, housing, mental health services, transportation services, etc.

**RISE Center**

Complete the "Request for SUD Treatment Services" and "Consent to Share Behavioral Health Information" up to 14 days prior to discharge to initiate screening process.

**Substance Use Access/ Eligibility Screening**

OCHN offers intake and ongoing services through telehealth or face-to-face based on individual needs.



**Criminal Justice Resource Coordination**

Assist with discharge planning, communication with an OCHN network provider, appointments and community resources.

**R.E.A.C.H. Coordination**

Connect individuals to mental health services, provide follow-up after discharge from jail, and assist with other community reentry needs.


**Mental Health Access Eligibility Screening**

Individuals who need intensive mental health services, and are Medicaid eligible, can be screened by a R.E.A.C.H. Coordinator up to 45 days prior to discharge.

**Mental Health Provider Network**

**Hope Shelter**

OCHN works with HOPE Shelter to help people leaving jail who are homeless. Refer to R.E.A.C.H. Coordinator for further assistance.
