Provider Network Priority Pillars

Oakland Community Health Network (OCHN) leads a provider service network that assists approximately 29,000 Oakland County citizens at more than 400 service sites across the county. To ensure service provider relationships are upheld, OCHN prioritizes the following pillars:

Accountability

Fulfill delegated responsibilities to manage a quality care service system for people served.

Collaboration

Partner to identify and meet the service needs of people served.

Communication

Learn, listen, respond, and share important information.

Respect

Use language and actions that uplift all network stakeholders, including people served.

Transparency

Ensure accessibility to critical service-related data and fiscal management reporting.
