OCHN Opioid Use Disorder “Health Home”

An Opioid Use Disorder (OUD) Health Home is a model of care that coordinates your **physical health, behavioral health, and social needs**. You receive recovery services and a **personalized** care plan from your provider team. Health Home participation is voluntary and does not limit a person's OUD services.
