




## Michigan's Substance Use Disorder Services are at Risk

Just like dominoes, cutting Medicaid initiates a cascade of losses that impacts the "buckets" of substance use disorder (SUD) funding



Michigan has **emerged a leader** in addressing the opioid pandemic **by investing** in SUD supports and services

Funding cuts **risk the progress** we have made and put **lives at risk**

decrease in drug related deaths in Oakland County in 2024

Michigan's overdose death rate has declined nearly

**5X**

the national average

**5.7%** ↓

decrease in Michigan overdose deaths in 2023

**Save a Life Stations:** Naloxone and overdose prevention

**Sober Support Unit:** Immediate 24/7 sober support

**Recovery Housing:** Sober supportive living environment

**Prevention Education:** Tools to prevent substance misuse

**Peer Support Specialists:** Trained individuals with lived experience providing crucial recovery support

## THE IMPACT ON PEOPLE

Lives lost due to preventable overdoses

Higher incarceration rates

Breakdown of family units and children entering foster care

Higher future substance use due to lack of prevention education
