## Substance Use Disorder "Health Home"



A Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Health Home is not a physical home, but a model of care that coordinates your **physical health, behavioral health, and social needs**. You receive recovery services and a **personalized** care plan from your provider team. Health Home participation is voluntary and does not limit a person's Substance Use Disorder services.

## Your First Steps Toward Recovery

Getting the support you need with recovery can be challenging. Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Health Homes help ease the process. SUD Health Homes are designed for individuals with a substance use disorder, as well as a physical diagnosis.

## What is a Health Home Program?

A Health Home allows all of your health care providers to coordinate your services, providing you with the best whole health care outcomes.

### Am I eligible?

You may be eligible for a SUD Health Home if you meet the following criteria:

- An active Substance Use Disorder (SUD)
- Physical health condition
- Oakland County resident
- Insurance determination based on eligibility

SUD Health Home participation is voluntary and does not limit a person's access to services and supports.



## Why participate in a Health Home?

Health Homes offer the extra support and access to services that promote your recovery journey.

### SUD Health Home Goals:

- Improve your outcomes and long-term recovery
- Reduce time coordinating physical health and behavioral health care
- Increase access and knowledge to health care that meets your needs
- Provide referrals to community and support services

## Get the help you need, the way you need it!

If you are interested in enrollment, speak with your case worker or one of OCHN's SUD Health Home providers.

Each SUD Health Home provider offers the same health home program and can answer your questions about program benefits or help you schedule an appointment.
